



Rochester Alumnae Panhellenic Scholarship Application Instructions

1. Check your eligibility – active membership in an NPC sorority chapter in good standing for 2019-2020 and a permanent or collegiate address with a zip code of 144_ _, 145_ _, or 146_ _ . Graduate students are eligible to apply (there are no address restrictions if the graduate student is an active dues paying member of a Rochester Alumnae Panhellenic group).
2. Use only the 2020-2021 application materials – contact information may have changed from prior year applications.
3. Complete all 3 pages of the attached application (RAP Scholarship Application 2020), including the autobiography. You may complete the application electronically or you may hand print the information on a hardcopy of the application. See # 6 below for deadline and submission instructions.
4. Arrange for a copy of your transcript to be sent to the email or street address below. This is not required to be an official transcript.
5. Request letters of recommendation from each of the following:
 - a. an educational recommendation (advisor, professor) – please, no fellow students and
 - b. a character reference (neighbor, employer, clergy) – please, no relatives

Complete the 2 fields on the ‘RAP Recommendations 2020’ and then provide a copy to each of your references. Ask them to submit their letters of recommendation to either the e-mail or the street address on the form. ***Note: It is important to follow up your requests to be certain they are completed and postmarked/mailed by the deadline.***

6. Your completed application, **postmarked no later than February 7, 2020**, should be submitted to the e-mail or street address below. You may include all of the parts of the application in one package or they may be submitted separately, but incomplete applications or those postmarked after the deadline may not be eligible for consideration. Please do not require signature for delivery for any expedited mailing service. Expedited mailing is not necessary as applications must only be postmarked by the above date, not delivered.
7. The Rochester Alumnae Panhellenic Scholarship Committee may request interviews with final candidates as part of the selection process.

9. Winners will be notified in **mid-March 2020**. Recipients will be invited to attend a special presentation luncheon in their honor, in the Rochester area, on April 18th, 2020. Details about the luncheon will be included in the notification letter. The actual scholarship check will be sent upon verification of enrollment for the Fall semester 2020.
